BONICA (MOD. SH.)	Soft rose pink	Long large sprays of cupped shaped blooms Glossy foliage.	S	R	100cm

CARDINAL DE RICHELIEU (GALL.)	Purple	Medium ball like blooms, near white on the reverse. Almost thorn free.	M	N	150cm
CHARLES DE MILLS (GALL.) (2)	Rich crimson	Large blooms with wavy petals, flat when fully open. Dark green foliage.	E	N	150cm
CHLOE (REN.)	Pale pink	Large old-fashioned style blooms. Glossy dark green pinnate foliage.	E	R	120cm
COMPTE DE CHAMBORD (POR.)	Deep pink	Double, full, flat blooms, pale translucent pink edges. Dark green foliage.	VS	C	120cm
CONSTANCE SPRY (MOD. SH.)	Pink	Large deeply-cupped blooms. Grows well as a climber. Tolerant of shade.	E	N	200cm
CORNELIA (HYB. MUS.)	Apricot/pink	Small blooms on large clusters. Mounding habit with dark green foliage.	ST	R	150cm
COTTAGE MAID (CENT.)	White/pink	Large clusters of double blooms, creamy white striped with pink.	M	N	150cm
ÉCLAIR (HYB. PERP.)	Dark red	Large double cupped blooms almost black.	ST	R	100cm
FANTIN LATOUR (CENT.)	Blush pink	Full petalled, flattish double blooms. Dark green foliage.	ST	N	120cm

FRU DAGMAR HARTROP (RUG.)	Flesh Pink	Single blooms, veined petals, with cream stamens. Large hips late summer.	ST	R	150cm
FRED LOADS (MOD. SH.)	Vermil. Orange	Large 5 petalled single blooms. Upright habit with glossy foliage.	M	R	180cm

GYPSY BOY (BOUR.)	Crimson purple	Large double blooms, golden stamens. Mid green foliage, arching habit.	E	N	180cm
JACQUELINE DU PRE (MOD. SH.)	Ivory white	Open cupped semi double blooms, prominent red and gold stamens.	ST	C	150cm
JACQUES CARTIER (PORT.)	Rich pink	Large flat rosette shaped booms, with numerous short scalloped petals.	VS	R	120cm
LOUISE ODIER (BOUR.)	Rose pink	Full trusses with large double camellia-like blooms.	VS	R	150cm
MACMILLAN NURSE	White/peach	Large old-fashioned rosette style blooms. Dark green foliage.	S	C	90cm
MADAME HARDY (DAM.)	Pure white	Double cupped blooms with green centre. Medium green foliage.	ST	N	150cm
MADAME ISSAC PERRIERE (BOUR.)	Deep pink	Large cup shaped blooms. Open growth, can be grown as a climber.	ST	R	200cm
MADAME PLANTIER (ALBA)	Milky white	Pompon shaped double blooms open from red tinged buds.	ST	N	180cm
MAIDENS BLUSH (ALBA.)	Warm pink	Loosely double, rosette-shaped blooms, fading to creamy pink.	M	N	180cm
MOYESSI GERANIUM (SPEC.)	Cherry red	Single blooms with cream stamens. Mid to dark green small foliage.	N	N	250cm
MRS. JOHN LAING (HYB. PERP.)	Soft pink	Very double, shapely blooms on upright bush. Successful in poor soils.	VS	R	120cm
PEARL DRIFT (MOD. SH.)	Pearly White	Semi-double blooms with golden stamen. Glossy foliage.	M	C	100cm
PENELOPE (HYB. MUS.)	Creamy pink	Semi-double blooms on large trusses. Will produce small coral pink hips.	M	R	180cm
PROSPERITY (HYB. MUS.)	Creamy white	Semi-double blooms in large clusters. Dark green foliage.	ST	R	200cm
QUEEN OF DENMARK (ALBA)	Soft pink	Large beautifully formed quartered blooms. Grey green foliage.	VS	N	150cm
RAUBRITTER (MAC.)	Clear Pink	Small globular blooms. Spreading habit. Dark green foliage.	S	N	75cm
REINE DE VIOLETTES (HYB.PERP.) (1)	Violet	Full petalled velvety blooms, bearing abundant leaves.	VS	C	150cm
ROSA COMPLICATA (GALL.)	Pink	Flat single blooms with pale centre. Good on light sandy soils Can climb.	S	N	200cm
ROSA GLAUCA (RUBRIFOLIA) (SPEC.)	Pink	Single blooms, followed by dark red hips. Purple tinted leaves & stems.	S	N	180cm
ROSA MUNDI (VERSCOLOUR) (GALL.)	Crim/pink/white	Small blooms, distinctly striped. Will succeed in poor soils.	S	N	120cm
ROSERAI DE L'HAY (RUG.)	Wine red	Velvety double blooms. Light green foliage.	VS	R	225cm
SALLY HOLMES (MOD. SH.)	Creamy white	Single blooms in in clusters on tall stems. Upright growth.	M	R	180cm
SARAH VAN FLEET (RUG.)	Mallow pink	Semi-double blooms. One of the earliest roses to flower.	VS	R	150cm
SOUVENIR DU DOCTEUR JARMAIN (HYB. PERP.)	Maroon	Medium sized blooms opening flat. Best out of full sun.	M	R	300cm
STANWELL PERPETUAL (SCOT.)	Blush pink	Double quartered blooms. Grey green foliage.	M	C	150cm
TUSCANY SUPERB (GALL.)	Deep crimson	Large semi-double blooms with golden stamens. Dark green foliage.	M	N	120cm
VARIEGATA DI BOLOGNA (BOUR.)	Blush pink	Fully double cupped blooms with crimson stripes.	M	C	150cm
WELL BEING (MOD. SH.)	Yell/orange/Pink	Double blooms yellow centre and flushed pink edge. Matt green foliage.	E	R	90cm
